LSTA GRANT OFFERINGS

The grant applications have been mailed to reviewers. We anticipate that LSTA Grant awards will be announced in August.

ADULT LITERACY GRANT OFFERINGS

For FY2010 the Adult Literacy Grant Program has received requests for more than \$7,785,761 to fund 191 projects at 113 agencies and libraries. In FY2009 about \$6.5 million dollars of federal and state funds were used to support adult literacy in three categories of service. This year's applications are as follows:

- 98 Adult Volunteer Literacy project applications requesting a total of \$5,372,963
- 55 Family Literacy project applications requesting a total of \$1,915,478
- 38 Workplace Skills Enhancement project applications requesting a total of \$497,320

By law, municipal library's annual reports are due 30 days after the close of their fiscal year and public library district's annual reports are due September 1.

BIBLIOSTAT CONNECT TRAINING

The Illinois State Library is pleased to announce the forthcoming availability of Bibliostat Connect. The statewide scheduled training sessions are off to a rousing start. Bibliostat Connect is the web-based, user-friendly program that will enable users to manipulate data elements from the Illinois Public Library Annual Reports (IPLAR, 1996-) and the ILLINET Interlibrary Loan Statistics (2005-).]

The training will specifically target public libraries using the IPLAR and ILLINET ILL statistical data. However, other types of libraries are encouraged to attend in order to discover how to access and utilize this product and data.

Participants will learn how to access Bibliostat Connect, develop an understanding of the web-based software's functionalities, identify methods to create queries in order to obtain desired results, and understand Connect's potential value and benefits related to identified local library needs.
